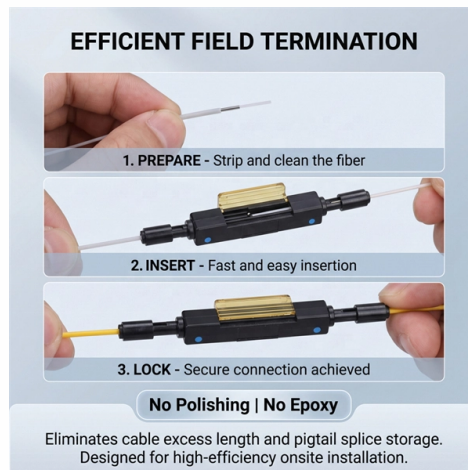


Fiber Optic Cable Shielding Connection

Shielded fiber optic cables should be grounded to prevent induced currents, maintain electrical safety, and avoid ground loops, typically connecting the shield to the building's main grounding bar or equipotential bonding network.

Purpose of Shielding and Grounding

Although the optical fibers themselves do not carry electrical current, metallic elements in shielded fiber optic cables—such as armor, reinforcing wires, or metallic shields—can conduct induced currents from nearby electrical systems or lightning strikes. Proper grounding ensures safety, prevents equipment damage, and maintains signal integrity by avoiding potential differences that could create ground loops or surges .

Grounding Practices

- **Single-End Grounding:** For most indoor installations, the shield is grounded at one end only, usually at the building entrance or main rack, connected to the telecommunications main grounding bar (TMGB) or the building's equipotential bonding network . This prevents ground loops.
- **Dual-End Grounding:** For installations between buildings, the shield should be grounded at both ends. Additional surge protection may be required to equalize potentials and protect against indirect lightning strikes .
- **Connection Materials:** Use green/yellow copper conductors with a cross-section according to local electrical codes (commonly $\geq 6 \text{ mm}^2$ in Spain) and keep the conductor as short and straight as possible .
