Overview of a Splice Box

A fiber optic splice box (also called a splice distributor) is a protective housing where fiber optic cables begin, end, or are joined. It serves as a central point for managing fiber connections, ensuring continuous data transmission while protecting fibers from environmental damage and mechanical stress. Splice boxes are used in indoor and outdoor applications, often mounted on DIN rails or in 19" racks, and can include hybrid designs supporting both fiber and copper connections.

Key Components

- **Splice Cassette/Tray:** Holds fibers and reserves, allowing organized splicing. Modern cassettes include splice trays, holders, couplings, and pigtails for easier installation.
- **Front Panel:** Contains connectors for transmitting signals via fiber or copper cables. It can be removed to facilitate splicing or maintenance.
- **Cable Entry/Exit Ports:** Allow fibers to enter and exit the box from above or below, maintaining proper bend radius and strain relief.
- **Housing:** Typically metal with IP20 protection, providing mechanical protection and environmental shielding.
