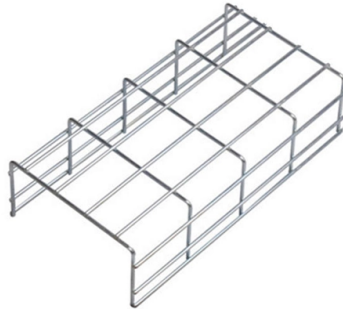


Fiber Optic Cable Tray Materials

Material Considerations

Cable trays for fiber optic cables are typically constructed from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, depending on environmental conditions and mechanical requirements. Steel trays are common for indoor industrial applications due to their strength, while aluminum and stainless steel are preferred in corrosive or outdoor environments for their resistance to rust and chemical degradation. Non-metallic trays, such as fiberglass reinforced plastic (FRP), may also be used in highly corrosive or wet environments.

Mechanical and Environmental Requirements

Fiber optic cables are sensitive to bending and crushing, so trays must provide adequate support without sharp edges. Trays should have smooth surfaces or protective coatings to prevent cable jacket damage. The tray material must withstand ambient temperature variations, UV exposure (for outdoor trays), and potential chemical exposure. Load-bearing capacity should be sufficient to support the weight of the installed fiber optic cables and any additional hardware like splice trays or enclosures.
