Its primary function is to efficiently manage and terminate fiber optic cables, connecting the cable's core to a pigtail. It offers higher reliability and more flexible deployment and configuration than traditional terminal boxes. This cable type has a small diameter core, allowing only a single light mode to pass through it. Hence, the number of light reflections that. It is the critical last link in FTTH (Fiber to the Home), FTTB (Fiber to the Building), and. The FBT accepts up to 48 fibers equipped with a variety of industry-standard.
