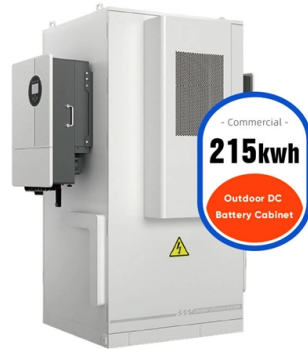


Fiber Optic Communication in Estonia
