LC connectors were developed by Lucent Technologies to replace larger SC and FC connectors, offering a compact 1.25 mm ferrule and a push-pull latch for easy insertion and removal. They are the de facto standard for SFP/SFP+, QSFP, and QSFP-DD transceivers, supporting duplex channels without compromising handling or port density. LC connectors are used in single-mode (OS2) and multimode (OM3/OM4/OM5) fiber networks, making them versatile for enterprise, telecom, and AI compute fabrics.

Key Features

- **High Density:** LC connectors allow more ports per patch panel unit, ideal for modern high-density racks.
- **Low Insertion Loss:** Typical insertion loss is ≤ 0.3 dB, with high-quality connectors achieving as low as 0.12 dB.
- **Duplex and Simplex Options:** Standard duplex LC cables have two separate boots, while Uniboot cables combine both fibers into a single boot, reducing bulk and improving airflow.
- **Polish Types:** LC connectors come in UPC (ultra-polished) and APC (angled) variants, with APC preferred for high return-loss applications like PON backbones.
