Unlike patch cords, which have connectors on both ends, pigtails allow for low-loss, permanent joints while maintaining the precision of factory connectors. They are widely used in single-mode fiber applications, optical distribution frames, and FTTH deployments.

Fabrication Process

Fiber Preparation

The first step in pigtail fabrication is fiber preparation, which includes spooling, stripping, and cleaning. Automated systems ensure consistent fiber lengths, proper buffer stripping, and thorough cleaning using ultrasonic or non-alcoholic fluids, reducing the risk of fiber damage and contamination. Maintaining the minimum bend radius during handling is critical to prevent microbends that can increase signal loss.
