A Fiber Optic Switch TX connects copper Ethernet (10/100/1000Base-TX) to fiber optic networks, supporting both singlemode and multimode fiber with various port configurations and duplex modes.

Overview

Fiber optic switches with TX ports are designed to bridge or convert copper Ethernet networks to fiber optic networks, enabling longer transmission distances and higher reliability. Common configurations include:

- 3-4 TX ports + 1-2 FX or SFP fiber ports for small to medium networks (e.g., EL100-X, TC3240) .
- 6 TX ports + 2 FX fiber ports for larger setups, supporting both half and full-duplex modes (e.g., GAOTek 6-Port switch) .
- Gigabit TX ports with dual SFP fiber modules for high-speed applications (e.g., ESW-2206) . These switches can operate in unmanaged or managed modes, with features like auto-negotiation, MDX/MDIX, VLAN support, and security settings depending on the model.

Fiber Types and Distance

- Singlemode (SM) fiber supports long-distance connections, up to 80–100 km depending on the switch and SFP module .
- Multimode (MM) fiber is suitable for shorter distances, typically within a few hundred meters to a few kilometers.
