

Fiber optic access box for the house

To use a fiber optic box (ONT) for home internet, connect the fiber line to the ONT, link the ONT to your router via Ethernet, and configure your network for access.

Step 1: Locate and Power the Fiber Optic Box

The fiber optic box, also called an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), is typically installed by your ISP inside your home, often in a closet, corner, or garage (). Ensure the ONT is plugged into a power outlet and that the status light is on. If the light is off, check the power connection.

Step 2: Connect the Fiber Line

Carefully connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated fiber port. Do not look directly into the fiber connector, as it can cause eye damage (). The ONT converts the light signals from the fiber into electrical signals that your router can use ().

Step 3: Link the ONT to Your Router

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT to your router or gateway. Plug one end into the ONT's Ethernet port and the other into the router's WAN or fiber port, often labeled "ONT" or "Fiber Jack" (). Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
