What Are Fiber Optic Patch Cords?

A fiber optic patch cord (also called a fiber jumper) is a short, pre-terminated fiber cable with connectors on both ends, used to connect devices such as switches, transceivers, and patch panels. They are designed for flexible, short-distance connections and are essential for the “last meter” of optical networks. Patch cords come in single-mode (9 μm core, long-distance) and multimode (50–62.5 μm core, short-distance, high-bandwidth) variants, with OM4 or OM5 recommended for modern data centers to support 40G and 100G connections.

What Are Fiber Optic Adapters?

A fiber optic adapter joins two fiber connectors, keeping them precisely aligned to allow light signals to pass with minimal loss. Adapters are commonly installed in patch panels, cassettes, or wall enclosures. They are available for single-fiber connectors (LC, SC) and multi-fiber connectors (MPO/MTP), supporting high-density and high-speed applications such as 40G, 100G, and 400G networks.
