

Fiber optic cable bent the power pole



Overview

Begin by examining all visible fiber optic cables. Look for sharp bends, kinks, or signs of crushing. Cables should maintain a minimum bend radius—typically 10 times the cable's outer diameter—to prevent signal loss. Installers must understand these specifications and know how to install cables. Those are fiber optic cables that are wound back and forth between those "snowshoe" devices, which are used to limit the bend radius of the fiber. Those are needed to avoid propagation losses due to the fiber being bent more than its rated maximum bend radius. The fiber must have so much slack. 4.
