Pre-terminated fiber optic cables are factory-assembled with connectors such as LC, SC, or MPO already installed and polished to precise specifications. These assemblies are tested in the factory to ensure consistent optical performance, allowing for plug-and-play installation with minimal tools required on-site, typically just basic installation tools . Advantages:

- Rapid installation, reducing labor time by up to 70% .
- Guaranteed connector quality and low optical loss.
- Minimal risk of termination errors.
- Ideal for projects with tight schedules or high-density cabling, such as 40/100 Gbps multimode networks or FTTH deployments . Considerations:
- Accurate cable length specification is critical to avoid excess slack or insufficient reach .
- Less flexibility for last-minute layout changes on-site.
