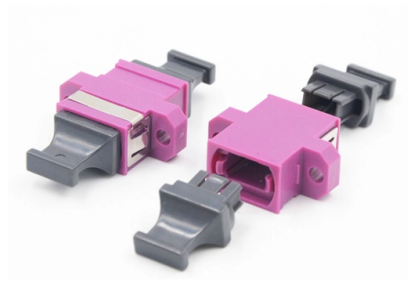


Fiber optic cable reel pulling

Gas-powered units like the Reel EZ Phantom offer 1,250 lbs of pulling force and can be mounted to a vehicle for roadside or long-run fiber deployment . **Capstan Systems:** Capstan wheels, typically 42 inches in diameter, allow controlled pulling of fiber optic cables while minimizing stress on the cable. These systems can be vehicle-mounted or portable, providing flexibility for different terrains and installation environments . **Mesh Bulk Reels and Grips:** Mesh pulling sleeves or bulk reels provide a secure grip on the cable without damaging the jacket. U-TECK's mesh bulk reels are abrasion-resistant and allow easy cutting and knotting, such as a bowline knot with a minimum 3-inch tail, to attach the cable to the puller . **Cable Drum Dispensers:** Lightweight spools or heavy-duty reels help manage cable storage and deployment, reducing tangling and facilitating smooth pulls .
