How Fiber Connects Switches

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light pulses, allowing switches to communicate over long distances without signal degradation, unlike traditional copper cables . This makes fiber ideal for connecting switches across buildings, campuses, or data centers . Fiber connections also provide higher bandwidth, lower latency, and enhanced security since they do not emit electromagnetic signals .

Required Equipment

- **SFP/SFP+ Modules:** Switches with fiber ports require Small Form-factor Pluggable (SFP) or SFP+ transceivers. SFP modules typically support 1G speeds, while SFP+ supports 10G, and QSFP modules handle even higher bandwidths .
- **Fiber Type:** Choose between single-mode (long-distance, higher bandwidth) or multimode (shorter distances, cost-effective) fiber based on distance and network requirements .
- **Connectors:** Most modern switches use LC connectors for duplex fiber, though SC or ST connectors may also be used depending on the hardware .
