

Fiber optic connector heat sink



Overview

Heat sinks address the thermal challenges of SFP cages by optimizing heat transfer away from critical components. Their core function is to increase the surface area available for heat dissipation, accelerating the transfer of thermal energy from the SFP module to the surrounding. Depending on the fiber diameter, these high-performance laser fiber cables ensure efficient laser transmission of more than 200 W while preventing overheating caused by unwanted cladding modes. The heat sink structure comprises an internal stationary heat sink in thermal contact.
