- **Splice Protection Sleeves:** After splicing, heat-shrink sleeves with a stainless steel core protect the fragile junction, providing mechanical strength and environmental protection .

Mechanical Splicing Option

For situations where fusion splicing is impractical, mechanical splice kits like the Corning CamSplice™ provide a simpler alternative. These kits use a self-centering fiber alignment mechanism and require minimal training. Average splice loss is around 0.15 dB, with a maximum of 0.3 dB, making them suitable for emergency restoration or indoor/outdoor pigtail splicing .
