

Fiber optic switch interface indicator lights



Article Overview

Fiber optic interface LEDs indicate port status, link activity, and signal health, with colors and blinking patterns providing key diagnostic information.

LED Colors and States

- Green (steady): The port is active and operating normally, with a valid link established .
- Green (blinking): Indicates data transmission or reception activity on the port .
- Amber/Orange (steady): The port has detected a fault, such as a misconfiguration, incompatible SFP, or a physical layer issue .
- Amber/Orange (blinking): May indicate errors, flapping links, or diagnostic activity during boot or POST .
- No light: The port is down, disabled, or not receiving power . Some switches, like SFP-DD ports, use tricolor LEDs (green/amber/white) to indicate the status of multiple logical ports on a single transceiver. A single white blink may indicate the first port, two white blinks the second port, followed by green or amber to show operational status .

Interpreting Activity

- Flashing LEDs: Normal during data transmission, but irregular or rapid flickering may indicate errors or marginal cable performance .
