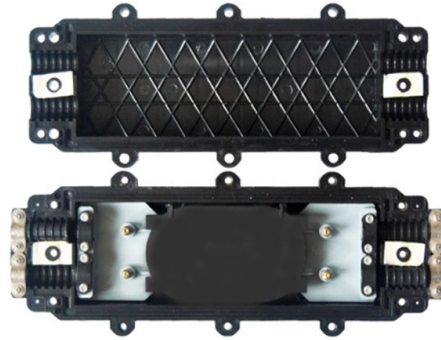


Fire main pipe distance from cable tray



Article Overview

The recommended minimum horizontal distance between a fire main pipe and a cable tray is generally 0.5 to 1 meter, depending on insulation and pipe type.

General Guidelines

- Insulated fire mains: If the fire main pipe is thermally insulated, a minimum parallel distance of 0.5 meters from the cable tray is recommended to prevent heat transfer and protect cable integrity .
- Uninsulated fire mains: For uninsulated pipes, the distance should be at least 1 meter, with additional measures such as heat shields or protective insulation to safeguard cables from heat radiation .
- Vertical arrangements: It is generally not recommended to install cable trays directly above fire mains. If unavoidable, maintain a minimum vertical gap of 1 meter and ensure proper insulation .

UK Fire-Rated Cable Considerations

For fire-rated or life-safety cables, UK standards (BS 7671, BS 8519, BS 5839) suggest that physical separation can be used as an alternative to barriers. A 300 mm horizontal air gap is commonly adopted between fire-rated cable trays and other services when a fire-rated barrier is impractical . This ensures circuit independence and reduces the risk of fire propagation.

Additional Safety Measures

- Corrosive or pressurized pipes: Maintain at least 0.5 meters distance and consider protective coatings or corrosion-resistant materials .
