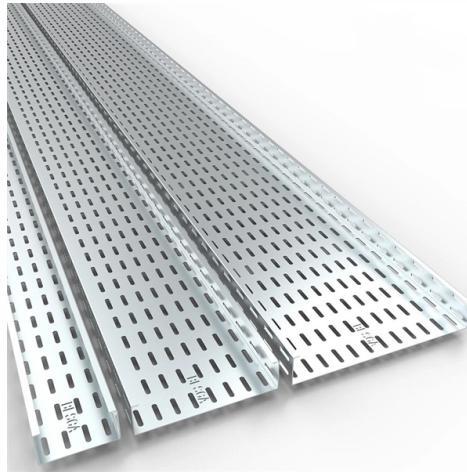


Function of Relay Protection and Distribution Devices

Core idea: A relay uses one electrical signal to switch, isolate, interlock, alarm, or command another circuit. What controls it: Relay selection.
