Steps for Connecting a Ground Wire

- **Locate the Grounding Bar or PE Bar** Open the distribution box and identify the grounding bar, often marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. This is the designated connection point for all ground wires in the box .
- **Connect the Power Ground Wire** Use a copper core wire with appropriate insulation (yellow-green) and a cross-sectional area meeting local standards. Strip the wire end, insert it into the terminal on the PE bar, and tighten the screw securely to ensure a firm connection .
- **Ground Electrical Components** Any electrical components inside the distribution box that require grounding should be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures safe operation and prevents potential electric shock .
- **Secure the Ground Wire** Fix the wire using screws, nuts, and washers to prevent loosening. Ensure all connections are clean, free of oxidation, and maintain good conductivity .
- **Test Grounding Resistance** Use a grounding resistance tester to verify that the resistance is within acceptable limits (typically
