Proper grounding of an outdoor distribution box ensures safety by providing a low-resistance path for fault currents, protecting people and equipment from electric shock and damage.

Importance of Grounding

Grounding an outdoor distribution box is critical because it:

- Reduces the risk of electric shock by preventing exposed metal parts from becoming energized.
- Protects electrical equipment from voltage surges, lightning strikes, and moisture-induced faults.
- Stabilizes voltage levels and ensures proper operation of circuit breakers and fuses during fault conditions . Outdoor environments increase exposure to water, humidity, and lightning, making grounding essential for safety .

Grounding Standards and Requirements

- Wire Size: In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is typically used; in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard .
- Connection Points: Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate, then from the mounting plate to the central grounding point .
