ExxonMobil Guyana's fibre optic cable has landed, Guyana Vice President Bharrat Jagdeo said during a December 28 press conference. Ongoing construction of an offshore command centre at Ogle, East Coast Demerara, is expected to conclude this year. The installation of the fibre optic cable is set to. Cable installation by using high speed air flow combined with additional mechanical pushing force is called as “blowing or jetting”. Compressed air is injected in the duct inlet after few hundred meters.
