

Height Requirements for Commercial Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Commercial distribution boxes should be mounted at heights that ensure accessibility, safety, and compliance with IEC, BS 7671, and NEC standards, typically between 1 meter and 2 meters from the floor.

Recommended Mounting Heights

- **Indoor Commercial Installations:** Distribution boxes are generally installed between 1 meter (3.3 ft) and 1.8 meters (5.9 ft) from the floor to allow easy access for operation, maintenance, and inspection, with a suggested height of 1.3 meters for elderly or handicapped personnel in commercial or public buildings (IEC 60364-5-52, BS 7671) .
- **Outdoor Installations:** Boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet (≈ 0.9 meters) above ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts .
- **Maximum Mounting Height:** According to NEC 2023, the top of a panelboard or disconnect switch should not exceed 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters) above the floor to maintain safe accessibility .

Clearance and Working Space Requirements

- **Front Clearance:** Minimum 3 feet (914 mm) in front of the equipment to allow safe operation and maintenance .
- **Side Clearance:** Minimum 30 inches (762 mm) from the sides of the equipment, or at least the width of the equipment itself .
