Overview

The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1. The bottom surface. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board. Ground-mounted foundations should be 50 to 100 mm above ground level.
