

Home electrical distribution box installed on the stairs



Article Overview

A home electrical distribution box should not be installed directly over stair steps, but it can be placed on a stair landing if proper clearance and safety requirements are met.

NEC Compliance and Safety Considerations

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), overcurrent protective devices (circuit breakers) cannot be installed over the steps of a stairway because this compromises the required working space and creates a safety hazard . However, a panelboard can be installed on a stairway landing as long as the necessary clearance in front of the panel is maintained, ensuring safe operation, inspection, and maintenance .

Required Clearances

- Front workspace: At least 36 inches (3 feet) in front of the panel must be clear for safe access .
- Side clearance: Minimum 30 inches wide to allow proper operation of breakers .
- Height: The center of the highest breaker should not exceed 6'7" (2.01 m) to comply with NEC accessibility requirements .
- Door operation: The panel door must open to at least 90 degrees without obstruction .
