Standard Burial Depths

For most installations, fiber optic cables are buried 24 to 36 inches (60-90 cm) deep to protect against accidental damage from landscaping, gardening, or light vehicular traffic . In areas with heavy vehicle traffic, roads, or industrial sites, cables are often buried 36 to 48 inches (90-120 cm) deep to withstand soil compression, vibrations, and potential excavation . Residential installations may use shallower depths, sometimes as little as 12 inches (30 cm), but this increases the risk of accidental damage .

Factors Affecting Burial Depth

- **Soil Type and Frost Line:** In cold climates, cables must be buried below the frost line (often 36 inches or more) to prevent frost heave, which can damage the glass fibers . Loose or sandy soils may require deeper burial to prevent shifting.
- **Cable Type:** Direct burial requires armored fiber optic cables with steel tape or dual jackets for rodent and moisture protection. Non-armored cables should not be buried directly .
- **Traffic Load:** Areas with heavy vehicles or road crossings require deeper burial or the use of rigid or PVC conduits to prevent crushing .
