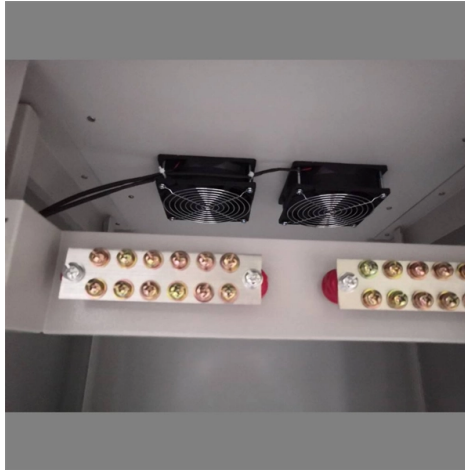


How far is the fiber optic cable from the pole head



Article Overview

The fiber optic cable is typically suspended from a hanger wire attached near the top of the pole, with a minimum vertical clearance of about 1.5 meters from the pole head or top of the pole.

Typical Installation Distances

In aerial fiber optic installations, the cable is fixed to a hanging wire or messenger wire that runs along the poles. The vertical distance from the top of the pole (pole head) to the cable is generally at least 1.5 meters, ensuring mechanical stability and safety from other utilities or environmental hazards. The horizontal distance from nearby power lines should exceed 2 meters to prevent electrical interference and maintain safety.

Pole Spacing and Cable Support

- Urban areas: Poles are typically spaced 25–40 meters apart, with concrete poles around 10–12 meters high.
- Suburban/rural areas: Wooden poles are spaced 40–50 meters apart, with heights of 12–15 meters.
- Extreme environments: Maximum spacing can reach 67 meters with reinforced poles. The fiber optic cable is usually attached to the lowest level of the pole's overhead lines, ensuring it does not interfere with power or communication lines. Only one fiber optic cable is typically hung per hanger wire, and the wire must be mechanically strong, often galvanized steel, with a safety factor of at least 3.
