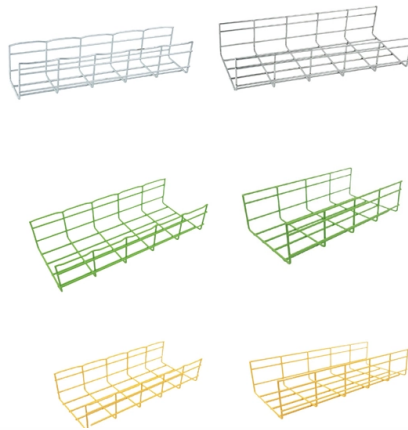


How high should the secondary distribution box be

A secondary distribution box is typically installed at a height that allows safe and convenient access for operation and maintenance, often between 1.2 to 1.8 meters above the floor or ground level.

Installation Context

A secondary distribution box receives low-voltage power from a distribution transformer and distributes it to individual units or equipment within a building or facility . It is part of a three-level distribution system:

- Primary distribution: High-voltage power from the substation to transformers.
- Secondary distribution: Low-voltage power from transformers to distribution boxes.
- Tertiary distribution: Final delivery to individual appliances or outlets .

Typical Mounting Height

While exact heights can vary depending on local codes, building design, and accessibility requirements:

- Indoor installations: Secondary boxes are usually mounted 1.2–1.8 meters above the floor, ensuring that operators can reach switches, breakers, and meters comfortably .
- Outdoor installations: Boxes may be mounted on walls or pedestals at a similar height, with additional considerations for weatherproofing and security .
