

How many centimeters should the cable tray be removed from the wall



Article Overview

Cable trays should generally be installed at least 15 centimeters (150 mm) away from the wall to allow proper clearance and maintenance access.

Clearance from Wall

For floor-mounted or wall-mounted cable trays, a minimum distance of 150 millimeters (15 cm) from the wall is recommended. This spacing ensures that cables are not obstructed, allows for proper ventilation, and provides sufficient room for maintenance or future cable additions (Apex Tray Standards), .

Vertical and Top Clearance

- Vertical spacing between floor-mounted trays and the wall or other structures should also maintain at least 150 mm to prevent obstruction and facilitate airflow .
- Top clearance from ceilings or overhead obstructions should be at least 300 mm to allow safe installation and inspection .

Additional Considerations

- Parallel trays: When installing multiple trays side by side, maintain at least 0.6 meters between them for maintenance access and heat dissipation .
- Power and signal separation: Keep at least 0.5 meters between power and signal trays to reduce electromagnetic interference, unless shielding is used, which can reduce the spacing to 0.3 meters .
