

How many grounding points does the indoor distribution box have



Article Overview

An indoor distribution box typically has at least two grounding points: one on the housing and one on the mounting plate, with additional connections to the central grounding system.

Grounding Configuration

For proper grounding of an indoor distribution box:

- Primary grounding point: Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate .
- Secondary grounding point: Connect a second grounding wire from the mounting plate to the factory central grounding point . This ensures that all metal parts of the distribution box are effectively bonded and the total ground resistance remains below 0.1 Ohm .

Additional Considerations

- LV panels and feeders: Each LV feeder is grounded through a minimum of four ground rods, and all accessible metal parts of LV network equipment, including panels and enclosures, are bonded to the neutral conductor .
- Wire specifications: In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is used, while in other markets a 6 mm² wire is standard .
- System safety: Proper grounding protects personnel from electric shock, stabilizes voltage levels, and ensures reliable operation of protective devices .
