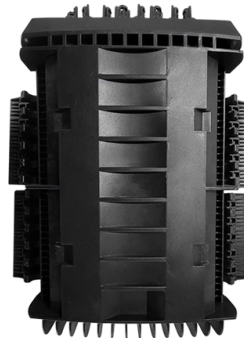


How many meters is the grounding distance for the distribution box



Overview

Distribution box and switch box should not exceed 30 meters. Generally, distribution boxes can be divided into three levels of secondary protection, that is, three levels of distribution boxes: general. Clearance: Electrical panels must be installed in a readily accessible area with a minimum clearance of 30 inches (762 mm) wide, 3 ft (36 inches or 914 mm) deep, and 6.5 feet (≈ 2 meter) high in front of the panel. The panelboard's door (hinged cover) shall be able to be opened to a full 90°. In industrial settings, you may need to adjust the height depending on the space and equipment around it. Leave enough space around the box for air to flow and for future. The bottom edge of the distribution box is usually between 1.8 meters above the ground, which is convenient for operation and inspection. It is recommended to use a. Minimum Contact: A rod electrode must have a minimum of 8 feet of its length in direct contact with the soil. Rod Types: Copper-Bonded Steel (common), Galvanized Steel, or Solid. The Grounding Electrode Conductor (GEC) is the wire that connects the meter box or main service panel to the grounding electrode.

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
