While most pigtails are single-fiber, multi-fiber options exist: Single-fiber: The most common (LC, SC, FC). Multi-fiber: 2, 4, 6, 12, 24, 48, or 72 fibers. Multi-fiber pigtails often come in ribbon format for splicing into high-count cables. Two main types: Jacket options: For a 144-port ODF, use 12-fiber LC UPC bunch pigtails.
