

How many switches are appropriate for a distribution box



Article Overview

The number of switches in a distribution box depends on your current electrical load, the number of outgoing circuits, and future expansion needs, with a typical household using 8-12 groups.

Determining the Number of Switches

The number of switches, often represented as MCBs or groups, should match the number of outgoing circuits in your installation. Each major appliance or high-power device—such as ovens, washing machines, dryers, or air conditioning units—should ideally have its own dedicated switch for safety and load management. Smaller loads like lighting or general-purpose outlets can be grouped together, but care must be taken to avoid overloading any single circuit.

Planning for Future Expansion

It is recommended to include one or two spare ways in the distribution box to accommodate future additions, such as electric vehicle chargers, solar panels, or additional appliances. This ensures flexibility without the need to replace the entire box later.

Safety and Compliance

Each switch should be paired with appropriate protective devices:

- MCBs for overload and short-circuit protection
- RCCBs or RCBOs for residual-current protection
