

How many watts is a normal electrical distribution box on a construction site

Construction site electrical distribution boxes typically handle between 10 kW and 100 kW, depending on site size, equipment, and peak load requirements.

Typical Power Capacity

The wattage of a construction site distribution box varies widely based on the size of the site, type of equipment, and simultaneous usage. Small sites with basic lighting and hand tools may require 10–20 kW, while larger sites with heavy machinery, compressors, and welding equipment can demand 50–100 kW or more at peak load . The total wattage should account for startup surges, as motors and compressors often draw more power when starting .

Load Calculation

To determine the appropriate distribution box wattage:

- List all equipment and their individual wattage ratings.
- Sum the wattage of devices that may operate simultaneously to find peak demand.
- Include startup surges for motors and compressors.
- Factor in future expansion for additional tools or temporary equipment .
