- **Circuit Planning:** Decide the number of circuits needed and apply diversity factors to avoid oversizing. Ensure the sum of outgoing breakers does not exceed the main breaker rating .
- **Compliance with Standards:** Follow IEC 61439, NEC, or local electrical codes for safety, labeling, and testing. This ensures proper insulation, short-circuit protection, and safe maintenance access .

- **Main Incomer:** Use an MCCB or MCB rated for the total incoming current .
