

How to Use a Double-Row Cold Aisle Cabinet

A double-row cold aisle cabinet is used to enclose the cold aisle between two rows of server racks, ensuring consistent cold air delivery to equipment intakes and preventing hot and cold air mixing.

Understanding the Double-Row Cold Aisle Setup

In a double-row cold aisle configuration, server racks are arranged back-to-back, forming a corridor known as the cold aisle. The fronts of the racks face each other, and cold air is supplied directly into this aisle from the data center's cooling units. The hot air exhaust from the back of the racks flows into the adjacent hot aisle, maintaining separation between hot and cold air streams .

Installation and Configuration

- **Ensure Uniform Rack Heights and Alignment:** The two rows of racks must have uniform heights and be aligned along the aisle to allow proper installation of containment panels and doors .
- **Install End Doors and Roof Panels:** Use sliding double doors at the ends of the aisle and roof panels above the racks to fully enclose the cold aisle. Clear acrylic or Lexan panels allow visibility and lighting while maintaining airflow control .
- **Modular and Adjustable Components:** Many containment systems come as modular kits with telescopic beams and adjustable frames, allowing them to fit different rack widths and lengths. Connect multiple kits for longer aisles if needed .
