

How to backfill directly buried optical cables

After laying the cable, a 30 cm protective layer of fine soil or sand should be backfilled gently, avoiding gravel, bricks, or hard soil blocks, and compacted manually to prevent damage. Direct-buried optical cables must be installed with proper trench preparation, adequate burial depth, careful handling to maintain bend radius, and protective backfilling to ensure long-term performance and safety.
