

How to check the circuits in a distribution box

To check circuits in a distribution box, first ensure safety, identify each circuit, and then test voltage or continuity using a multimeter.

Safety First

Before opening a distribution box, turn off the main power and ensure no one can switch it back on while you work. Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses, and make sure the area is dry and well-lit. Never touch wires with wet hands, and if you are unsure, consult a licensed electrician .

Identify Circuits

Open the panel carefully by loosening the screws and lifting the cover. Look for labels or a circuit chart that indicate which breaker controls which area or appliance. Check for MCBs, RCDs, or RCBOs, which protect individual circuits. Note the voltage rating, current rating, and type of each breaker .

Testing Circuits

- **Visual Inspection:** Check for loose wires, damaged insulation, or signs of overheating. Ensure all connections on busbars, neutral bars, and earth bars are secure .
- **Voltage Measurement:** Use a multimeter to measure voltage at the incoming supply and at each outgoing circuit. Compare readings to ensure proper power delivery and detect voltage drops .
