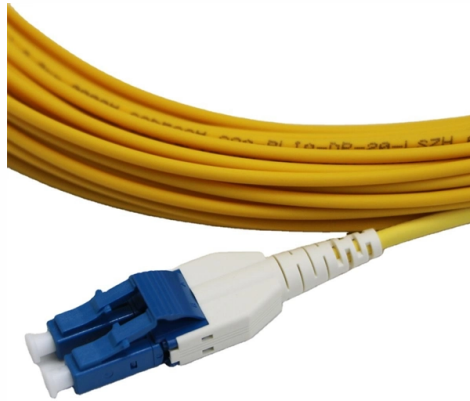


How to classify fiber optic terminal boxes into 1 2 3 and 4

Fiber optic terminal boxes are commonly classified by the number of ports or connections they support, typically ranging from 1 to 4 ports for residential and small-scale FTTH applications.

Classification by Port Count

- **1-Port Terminal Box:** Designed for a single fiber connection, ideal for individual residential units or small offices. It provides a compact solution for connecting a drop cable to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) with minimal space requirements .
- **2-Port Terminal Box:** Supports two fiber connections, suitable for duplex connections or small multi-dwelling units (MDUs). It allows for redundancy or simultaneous service to two endpoints .
- **3-Port Terminal Box:** Less common but used in scenarios where three separate fiber connections are needed, such as small office clusters or specialized residential setups. It balances compact size with moderate capacity .
- **4-Port Terminal Box:** Provides four fiber connections, often used in larger residential units, villas, or small commercial buildings. It allows multiple ONTs or devices to be connected from a single distribution point .
