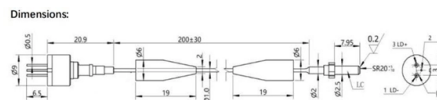


How to cold-connect pigtails

Cold-joining pigtails involves mechanically connecting wires or fibers without heat, using twisting, connectors, or specialized cold splicing tools.

Cold-Joining Electrical Wire Pigtails

- **Strip the Wires:** Remove about 1–2 cm of insulation from each wire end to expose the conductor .
- **Align and Twist:** Place the exposed ends adjacent-parallel or in an “X” shape, then twist them together until the insulation is reached .
- **Secure the Connection:** Use a wire nut, snap-on connector, or wrap with electrical tape to insulate and stabilize the joint .
- **Optional Reinforcement:** For semi-permanent connections, slide heat-shrink tubing over the joint and compress it to protect against mechanical stress . This method is quick, does not require soldering, and is suitable for low-voltage or temporary applications.

Cold-Joining Fiber Optic Pigtails

- **Prepare the Fiber:** Strip about 3 cm of the fiber coating and clean the glass with 99% isopropyl alcohol .
- **Install Cold Connector:** Insert the fiber into a mechanical cold splice connector, ensuring it seats properly in the V-groove or alignment slot .
- **Secure the Fiber:** Snap the connector's locking mechanism to hold the fiber in place, creating a precise butt joint between the pigtail and the incoming fiber .
