

How to configure the electrical distribution box in a shopping mall

Proper arrangement of electrical distribution boxes in a shopping mall requires zoning by load type, modular design, compliance with safety standards, and strategic placement for accessibility and reliability.

Zoning and Load Separation

In a shopping mall, electrical loads vary widely—from lighting, escalators, and HVAC systems to store equipment and emergency systems. To prevent interference and ensure reliability, distribution boxes should be zoned according to load type and power requirements. For example, separate boxes for:

- Low-power store lighting and small display equipment
- Medium-power systems like floor-level air conditioning and ventilation
- High-power systems such as escalators, elevators, and large HVAC units
- Emergency and fire protection systems This separation allows rapid fault isolation, so a problem in one zone does not disrupt the entire mall operation .

Hierarchical Distribution Structure

A hierarchical approach is recommended:

- Main incoming line: Connects to the mall's primary power source.
- Regional distribution: Feeds each floor or major section.
