

How to connect a fiber optic cable without a terminal box

You can set up fiber optic cable without a terminal box by using pre-terminated fiber with LC connectors and media converters to link devices directly.

Choosing the Right Cable

For DIY installations, single-mode fiber is recommended for long distances and high bandwidth, while multi-mode fiber can be used for shorter runs. Pre-terminated cables with LC or SC connectors simplify installation, eliminating the need for field splicing or a terminal box .

Direct Connection Using Media Converters

If you want to bypass a terminal box or ONT, you can use fiber media converters on each end of the fiber run. These devices convert optical signals to Ethernet, allowing you to connect directly to a router or switch. For example:

- Install a media converter near your main router.
- Run the fiber cable to the remote location.
- Connect the fiber to a second media converter, then to your device or switch .

- Protect the cable: Use conduit or direct-burial fiber to prevent damage from physical stress, pests, or renovations .
