Step 1: Understand the Fiber Pigtail

A fiber optic pigtail is a short fiber cable with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The connector end plugs directly into an optical module, patch panel, or ODF port, while the bare end is designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to the incoming fiber cable. Pigtails are preferred over patch cords for field terminations because they provide factory-polished connectors and reduce signal loss.

Step 2: Prepare the Fiber and Tools

Before splicing, gather the necessary tools:

- Fusion splicer
- Fiber cleaver
- Fiber stripper
- Isopropyl alcohol wipes
