

How to determine the wiring sequence of a terminal box

Step 1: Identify Circuits and Terminals

Step 2: Prepare the Wires

Cut wires to the appropriate length, leaving enough slack for maintenance but avoiding clutter. Strip insulation carefully (typically 6-10 mm depending on the terminal type) to expose the conductor without damaging it. For stranded wires, consider using ferrules to ensure a secure connection .

Step 3: Determine Connection Order

- **Power and Neutral:** Connect the main power supply wires first, followed by neutral lines. This ensures that the circuit is properly referenced and reduces the risk of accidental shorts.
- **Grounding:** Attach grounding wires to the designated terminal or bus bar before connecting other circuits to maintain safety.
