

How to directly thread cables through cable trays



Article Overview

Threading cables into cable trays involves careful planning, proper support, and safe handling to ensure cables are organized, protected, and compliant with electrical codes.

Step 1: Plan the Layout

Before threading cables, determine the cable tray route and layout. Mark the path using a chalk line or laser level, noting bends, tees, and elevation changes. Ensure the pathway is clear of obstructions such as pipes, HVAC ducts, or other equipment. Check local electrical codes for tray fill ratios (typically max 50%) and support spacing (usually every 1.5–2 meters) to prevent overloading the tray .

Step 2: Prepare the Tray and Supports

Install the cable tray supports first, either via wall brackets (cantilever) or ceiling suspension (trapeze or C-hanger). Ensure supports are level and spaced according to manufacturer specifications. Cut tray sections to fit the route, and deburr edges to prevent cable damage . Join tray sections securely using splice plates, bolts, or quick-connect systems depending on the tray type .

Step 3: Select and Prepare Cables

Group cables by type (power, data, instrumentation) and ensure they are within the tray's load capacity. Maintain proper bend radius to avoid stress on the cables, especially at tray exits or bends .
