

How to distinguish left from right wires in a distribution box



Overview

Wiring Direction: Wiring between the main circuit breaker and each branch circuit breaker in the box generally goes on the left, and the wiring out of the distribution box generally goes on the right. **Wire color:** The neutral wire is blue, and the color of the phase wire (A phase is yellow, B phase is green, and C phase is red). The term line side is used to describe the wires that are delivering the power to the box. If you are uncertain which wires are line side wires, you can disconnect the wires from any receptacle or switch and test for voltage. When installing the empty box, first pay attention to the position of the empty box installation hole of the box cover to ensure that the empty box position is in the reserved position of the box cover. Secondly, when installing the switch, please arrange it from left to right. The reserved. **Wiring requirements of distribution box** Upper incoming line, lower outgoing line, main circuit on the left, control circuit on the right, horizontal and vertical.
