

How to hoist cable trays to the roof

Overview

Horizontal hoisting is a common method for installing cable trays, especially when overhead support is available. Rooftop cable tray carries the electrical and data backbone of a building, and how it is supported decides whether that backbone stays organized, code-compliant, and off a roof it could otherwise damage. Drilling through the membrane creates potential leak points and can jeopardize roof warranty. Cable tray installation on roof plays a crucial role in organizing and protecting electrical cables, particularly in commercial or industrial settings. Rooftop installations are often subjected to harsh environmental conditions, including extreme temperatures, high winds, and exposure to UV. Commercial rooftops create a very different environment for management of cable tray supports than interior spaces. Layout isolation pads, (provided by contractor), according to the design and layout.
