

# How to insert a dual-core optical module into a switch



## Article Overview

To insert a dual-core optical module into a switch, handle it carefully, align it with the port, insert it straight until it clicks, and secure it using the latch mechanism.

### Preparation

- **Check Compatibility:** Ensure the switch supports the module type (SFP, SFP+, or QSFP+) and the correct fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) for your dual-core module .
- **Power and ESD Precautions:** Power off the switch if hot-swapping is not supported. Wear an anti-static wrist strap or ground yourself to prevent electrostatic discharge .
- **Clean Environment:** Work in a dust-free area and avoid touching the optical connectors to prevent contamination .

### Insertion Steps

- **Locate the Slot:** Identify the correct SFP/SFP+ slot on the switch, often labeled near the port .
- **Remove Dust Covers:** If the slot or module has dust caps, remove them carefully without touching the connectors .
- **Align the Module:** Hold the module by its sides, with the label facing up and the connector side facing down. Ensure the keying mechanism matches the slot .
- **Insert the Module:** Gently push the module straight into the slot until you hear or feel a click. Avoid forcing it at an angle to prevent damage .
