

How to insert an optical module into the PON port



Article Overview

To insert an optical module into a PON port, carefully align the module with the port, push it gently until it clicks, and verify it is securely seated.

Step-by-Step Procedure

- Prepare the Module and Port
- Unpack the optical module carefully and remove any protective packaging .
- Ensure the PON port is clean and free of dust; if unused, leave the dust plug in place until installation .
- Wear anti-static gloves or an anti-static wrist strap to prevent electrostatic discharge .
- Align the Module
- Hold the optical module by its sides and align it horizontally with the PON port .
- Check for any latch or locking tab on the module that may need to be engaged during insertion .
- Insert the Module
- Gently push the module into the port without using excessive force .
- You should hear or feel a slight “snap” as the spring mechanism secures the module in place .
- If the module has a latch, ensure it is fully engaged to prevent accidental disconnection .
