

How to jumper wires on the distribution box

Jumper wires in a distribution box are installed to connect multiple terminals or circuit breakers, ensuring proper power distribution while following safety and manufacturer guidelines.

Step 1: Understand the Jumper Types

- **Terminal Block Jumpers:** Used to connect adjacent terminal blocks for power or signal distribution. They come in various sizes and must match the specific terminal block type .
- **Circuit Breaker Jumpers:** Designed to connect multiple breakers, allowing a single input wire to distribute power across several breakers .
- **Wire Jumpers:** Flexible insulated wires that can be cut to length and used when pre-made jumpers are unavailable .

Step 2: Prepare the Distribution Box

- Turn off all power to the distribution box before starting.
- Identify the terminals or breakers that need to be connected. Clearly mark them to avoid incorrect connections .
- Select the correct jumper based on the terminal spacing and current rating.

Step 3: Install Terminal Block Jumpers

- Insert the jumper into the designated slots at the top of the terminal blocks.
